

The Chapel Hill Cooperative Suzuki Project is pleased to announce the **Annual Fall Workshop** being held this year **November 16 -18, 2007**. The Saturday, November 17th workshop will take place at the Chapel Hill Bible Church at 260 Erwin Road in Chapel Hill. Guest clinicians include Terry Durbin, Ruth Johnsen, Anne Stevenson-Stohl, Edith Gettes, Kat Smith-Payseur, Holly Talton and Phil Warren.

Students will participate in four classes: one or two group classes with Terry Durbin, smaller group classes, play-in, fiddle for younger students, sight reading/chamber class for more advanced students and the final recital. Pre-Twinklers will have a group class, play-in and the final recital. Advanced students will study with Mr. Durbin on Friday evening at the home of Nancy Brooks. Master classes on Friday and Sunday will be given at the home of Nancy Brooks, 413 Granville Rd., Chapel Hill, 27514. Master class is an excellent opportunity to observe and study one on one with one of the guest clinicians. Students present a polished piece and the fresh input of a guest clinician is very helpful and motivating.

A list of the repertoire for the Saturday Workshop follows below. Underlined pieces indicate works that will be performed on the final recital and which Terry Durbin will study with students in his classes. All the pieces on the list may be studied in other classes. Chamber music and the Seitz Concerto for advanced students will be made available to you through your instructor soon.

Volume 4A: 2nd Seitz (No.), Vivaldi A Minor, 1st mvt.

Volume 4B/5: Bach Double Concerto, Country Dance, Vivaldi A Minor, 2nd mvt.

Volume 6: Rameau Gavotte

Advanced: Seitz Concerto No. 4 in D, 1st mvt.
